DOLE AGAIN URGES WITHDRAWAL OF SORENSEN NOMINATION

WASHINGTON, D.C.-- Senator Bob Dole today renewed his suggestion that Theodore Sorensen withdraw his name from consideration as C.I.A. Director. "When there are so many other highly qualified people, it's unbelievable that the highest intelligence official should have little or no experience in managing a large agency and should have a questionable view about the value of intelligence in the formulation of national policy," Dole said.
