FARM HEARING IN GOODLAND AND WORKING LUNCHEON IN LIBERAL SCHEDULED FOR FEBRUARY 12

Senator Bob Dole will conduct an official Agriculture Committee field hearing in Goodland on Saturday, February 12, from 2:15 to 4:15 p.m. (Mountain Standard Time). The public hearing will take place at the Elks Club, 1523 Arcade. There will be eight panels of witnesses to discuss separate farm issues, including wheat, livestock, sugar beets, irrigation, financial needs and resources and farm organizations. Persons wishing to make their views known to the Agriculture Committee should bring prepared statements which will be submitted as part of the official hearing record.

The working luncheon in Liberal will take place between 11:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. (Central Standard Time) at the Student Union Conference Center at Seward County Community Junior College. At the luncheon, Senator Dole will invite discussion and questions on agriculture and other federal issues. Cost of the luncheon will be \$2.00 and reservations may be made by calling the Liberal Chamber of Commerce (316/624-3855). Reservations are not required, although they would be helpful, and persons wishing to take part in the discussion, but not the lunch, are invited.
