ADDITIONAL AGRICULTURE COMMITTEE FIELD HEARINGS SCHEDULED

Washington, D.C. ----- Senator Bob Dole today announced that additional field hearings will be held by the Senate Agriculture Committee in Manhattan, Hutchinson, and Winfield. Senator Dole will chair the hearings.

A hearing in Goodland and working luncheon in Liberal were announced earlier. All field hearings and the luncheon are open to the public.

Specific times and places for Manhattan, Hutchinson, and Winfield will be announced later.

Testimony will be taken on the farm programs for wheat and feedgrain, farm credit needs, livestock, sugar beets, irrigation, and other issues related to farm legislation.
