LENORA MORAGNE JOINS DOLE STAFF

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole has announced the appointment of Lenora Moragne, Ph.D., R.D., as his legislative assistant for nutrition and related fields.

Before joining Dole's staff, Dr. Moragne served for four years as Head of Nutrition Education and Training for the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Food and Nutrition Service. This Agency administers four federal food assistance programs -- Food Stamps, Food Distribution, Child Nutrition, and the Special Supplemental Food Program For Women, Infants and Children (WIC). Prior to working for U.S.D.A., she worked as a nutrition publicist for General Foods Corporation.

Dr. Moragne received her undergraduate degree in dietetics from Iowa State University in Ames. Following a dietetic internship with the Veterans Administration she worked as Chief Dietitian of the Community Hospital in Evanston, Illinois. After earning M.S. and Ph.D. degrees from Cornell University, Dr. Moragne taught graduate and undergraduate courses in foods, nutrition, and food service management at New York City's Hunter College and Columbia University.

The author of over a dozen technical articles in professional journals, she co-authored a junior high school nutrition textbook for McGraw Hill Book Company. She is an active member of the Future Development Commission of the American Home Economics Association (AHEA), the International Committee of AHEA, the Editorial Board of the new research journal of the American School Foodservice Association (ASFSA), and recently served as a judge in the FAMILY CIRCLE magazine Gold Leaf Award to business and industry groups for outstanding achievements in nutrition education.

Listed in the WORLD'S WHO'S WHO OF WOMEN, 1977, and WHO'S WHO IN BLACK AMERICA, Dr. Moragne and her husband reside in the District of Columbia.

Senator Dole is a member of the Senate Select Committee on Nutrition and is the ranking Republican on the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry and its Nutrition Subcommittee.
