DOLE RELEASES FEC REPORT, SENATE FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE

WASHINGTON-- Senator Bob Dole (R.-Kansas) released his Federal Election Commission financial disclosure report and his Senate Financial Disclosure Statement late yesterday.

The documents are also on file at the appropriate offices.

Senator Dole, an announced candidate for the Republican nomination to the Presidency of the United States, stated Monday that he plans to make a full and complete report of his finances within the next two weeks-- a report more detailed than those required by the Senate and the F.E.C.-- and he expressed his hope that other GOP candidates would do the same.

Senator Dole made a full financial disclosure in 1976, when he was his Party's vice-presidential nominee.
