DOLE URGES AMERICANS TO REMAIN CALM ON IRAN HOSTAGE SITUATION

WASHINGTON -- Following is a statement by Senator Bob Dole (R-Kan.) in reaction to President Carter's news conference this evening:

"Tonight, as for the last 25 nights, America has but one president. At this time you will hear no denunciations of past mistakes from this senator. Neither will I indulge in personal diplomacy.

"The next few days may be crucial in determining the fate of the Americans in Teheran. To every American who shares my outrage, shock and personal horror at the barbarity of the Khomeini regime, I ask nonetheless that we restrain our indignation in the hope of an ultimate solution. I would hope that tonight we would be a nation of peacemakers."
