DOLE UNDERGOES SURGERY FOR REMOVAL OF KIDNEY STONE

WASHINGTON -- Senator Bob Dole (R.-Kansas) underwent surgery this morning at Walter Reed Army Medical Center in Washington for removal of a kidney stone. Dole was admitted to Walter Reed early this morning and surgery was performed shortly after 10 a.m.

Dole was at his home when he began experiencing discomfort, and was taken to Walter Reed by his wife, Elizabeth. Doctors say Dole's vital signs are normal, and that otherwise the senator is in excellent health.

It is unclear how long the senator may be away from his Senate duties.
