## MAX KLEIN JOINS DOLE STAFF

WASHINGTON -- Senator Bob Dole, R.-KS, today announced the appointment of Topekan Max Klein to his Senate staff as a Kansas Legislative Representative. Klein will work out of the Senator's Topeka Office.

Klein was born in Glasco, Kansas, and is a 1947 graduate of Kansas State University. He joined the Southwestern Bell Telephone Company that year, and rose in the organization from a sales position to Assistant Vice President. From December of 1968 until his retirement in April of this year, Klein was responsible for revenue programs, negotiation of contracts and service arrangements for non-Bell telephone companies in Kansas, public affairs, government relations, and other supervisory projects.

"I am very pleased to have Max on board," said Senator Dole. "His broad experience and knowledge of our state will be invaluable and I look forward to working with him."

Klein will assist Senator Dole by working in the state on federal legislation, Kansas issues, and community projects. He has served on the boards of many civic and community organizations, including the Kansas Association of Commerce and Industry, the Kansas State University Alumni Association, and the Kansas Telephone Association.
