DOLE AND KENNEDY HEAD MAJOR SENATE AND PEOPLE'S COALITION FOR
WITHHOLDING ON INTEREST AND DIVIDENDS

PRESS CONFERENCE AT 11:30 TODAY, SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE ROOM

WASHINGTON -- Senate Finance Committee Chairman Bob Dole (R.-Kan.) has announced that a broad coalition of Senate leaders and organizations supporting withholding on interest and dividend income will be represented at a Thursday morning press conference (11:30am, Senate Finance Committee hearing room - 215 Dirksen).

Joining Dole will be Senator Edward Kennedy (D.-Mass.), Senator Dave Durenberger (R.-Minn.), Senator John Danforth (R.-Mo.), Senator Howard Metzenbaum (D.-Ohio), and an impressive coalition of civil rights, consumer, labor and citizen groups.

Dole said that the coalition will include the AFL-CIO, Common Cause, Citizens for Tax Justice, National Organization of Women, Congress Watch, Children's Defense Fund, the Consumer League and many other organizations will be present at Thursday's press conference.
