DOLE TO SPEAK AT KANSAS AMERICAN LEGION STATE CONVENTION,
WASHBURN LAW SCHOOL COMMENCEMENT;
WILL RECEIVE KU DISTINGUISHED SERVICE CITATION

WASHINGTON -- Kansas Senator Bob Dole will have a busy day in Topeka and Lawrence on Saturday, May 14, 1983. Dole will begin in Topeka, where he will address the Kansas American Legion State Convention. The Finance Committee Chairman will give his views on current foreign policy and defense issues. He will also speak at the Washburn University School of Law Commencement ceremonies about the present state of the legal profession in America. Dole, a Washburn Law School graduate, is Chairman of the Senate Judiciary Subcommittee on the Courts.

Saturday evening, Senator Dole will travel to Lawrence where he will be one of five Kansans to be honored with the University of Kansas and KU Alumni Association's Distinguished Service Citation for significant contributions to benefit society.
