DOLE GIVES PRESIDENT "A" ON SUMMIT

WASHINGTON -- Senate Finance Committee Chairman Bob Dole (R-Kan.) today gave President Reagan high marks for his work at the Economic Summit held at Williamsburg, Virginia over the weekend.

"There's no question about it, the President has earned a solid 'A' for his performance at Williamsburg," said Dole. "This was an extremely important time for these leaders to meet -- there's a lot at stake and much to be done before economic recovery is complete. In my view, it was essential for the President of the United States to display a keen understanding of the world economic situation, to be the key player at the conference and to make sure the seven nations emerged from the Summit as a unified, determined coalition. Under great pressure, it is clear that President Reagan accomplished these objectives during this past weekend."
