KANSAS RESIDENT EVE NORTON OF SALINA INTERNS FOR SENATOR DOLE

WASHINGTON -- Eve Norton, daughter of Frank and Jeanne Norton of Salina, recently completed a four-week internship in Washington, D.C. with Senator Dole.

Eve, a junior at Texas Christian University, worked as a member of the Senator's personal staff. During her internship, Eve conducted research on legislative issues involving the sub-minimum wage and the Job Training Program.

According to Eve, her internship was "a great experience. Working on a Senate staff enabled me to learn specific legislative issues, as well as the process of the Senate itself."

Senator Dole runs one of the largest internship programs on Capitol Hill, employing over 30 Kansas students each summer.
