INTERNS FOR SENATOR DOLE

WASHINGTON -- Kelly Presta, son of Mrs. Pat Presta of Scott City, recently completed a six-week internship in Washington, D.C. with Senator Bob Dole.

Kelly, a senior at Kansas State University, worked as a member of the Senator's Judiciary Committee staff. During his internship, Kelly worked on several special projects. He organized Senate hearings concerning Federal Identification Systems and public fraud. Kelly also researched legislation that would eliminate sexual discrimination in the United States Code.

According to Kelly, his internship was an exciting experience that helped him "gain a much better understanding of our government. Reading about the government in a civic's class is fine, but working in Washington for a U.S. Senator has been one of the best educational experiences I have ever had."

Senator Dole runs one of the largest internship programs on Capitol Hill, employing over 30 Kansas students each summer. According to Dole, "Internships are a valuable educational experience for young Kansans interested in government and politics. I am pleased that we have been able to afford that opportunity to bright, enthusiastic students like Kelly."
