KANSAS RESIDENT ROGER RAMSEYER OF PRAIRIE VILLAGE

INTERNS FOR SENATOR DOLE

WASHINGTON -- Roger Ramseyer, son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert Ramseyer of Prairie Village, recently completed a four-week internship in Washington, D.C. with Senator Bob Dole.

Roger, a senior at the University of Kansas, worked as a member of the Senator's Judiciary Committee staff. During his internship, Roger worked on several special projects. He helped set up hearings concerning Federal Identification Systems, and also researched legislation that would eliminate sexual discrimination in the United States Code.

According to Roger, his internship was an exciting experience that helped him "to gain a much better understanding of our government."

Senator Dole runs one of the largest internship programs on Capitol Hill, employing over 30 Kansas students each summer.
