DOLE, KASSEBAUM ANNOUNCE HUD GRANTS

FOR WICHITA, KANSAS CITY AND LAWRENCE

WASHINGTON -- Kansas Senators Bob Dole and Nancy Kassebaum today announced that Wichita, Kansas City, and Lawrence have been awarded a total of \$5,053,730 in grant money from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

Wichita will receive \$3,470,000 in Community Development Block Grant funds for street improvements, storm sewer construction, historic preservation, housing rehabilitation, citizen participation, acquisition and relocation. In addition, the Wichita Housing Authority has been awarded \$43,730 for low income housing programs.

Community Development Block Grant funding totalling \$774,000 has been approved for Kansas City, Kansas to be used for capital improvements, rehabilitation assistance, public services, and elimination of architectural barriers.

The City of Lawrence has been awarded \$766,000 in Community Development Block Grant funds. That money is to be used for drainage improvements, sidewalk renovation, waterline, park design development, neighborhood facilities, housing rehabilitation, and removal of architectural barriers.
