DOLE, KASSEBAUM ANNOUNCE HUD GRANTS FOR KANSAS

STATE AWARDED MORE THAN \$4 MILLION

WASHINGTON -- Kansas Senators Bob Dole and Nancy Kassebaum today announced that the State of Kansas has been awarded a total of \$4,029,900 in Housing and Urban Development grants. The section 202 funds are used to provide advice and technical assistance to non-profit sponsors of housing projects for elderly or handicapped citizens. In addition, interest-free loans are authorized to cover up to 80 percent of the preconstruction costs incurred by nonprofit sponsors in planning a federally assisted section 202 housing project.
