DOLE TO SPEAK ON DEFICIT REDUCTION TONIGHT AT HYATT;
SENATOR AND SECRETARY DOLE TO APPEAR ON
CNN's "FREEMAN REPORTS" NATIONWIDE TV SHOW WEDNESDAY NIGHT

WASHINGTON -- Senate Finance Committee Chairman Bob Dole (R-KS) will speak tonight to the National Meat Association Board of Directors at 7:30 p.m. in the Hyatt Regency Capitol Hill Hotel's Ticonderoga Room. The Kansas Republican will speak about his efforts to reduce soaring federal deficits with a three-year spending reduction and tax reform package.

Wednesday night, the Senator and Transportation Secretary Elizabeth Dole will make a "live" joint appearance on Cable News Network's Sandi Freeman show.

The one-hour "Freeman Reports" airs at 10:00 p.m. Washington time on the CNN Channel. Host Sandi Freeman will interview the Doles, who will also answer questions telephoned to them from viewers across the country.
