DOLE HAILS GUESS APPOINTMENT TO CIVIL RIGHTS PANEL

WASHINGTON -- Kansas Senator Bob Dole, a member of the Senate Judiciary Committee and one of the key negotiators in working out the Civil Rights Commission compromise, issued the following statement in response to Senator Howard Baker's appointment of Francis Guess to the reconstituted Civil Rights Commission:

"Senator Baker has made a good choice in his appointment of Commissioner Guess to the Civil Rights Commission. Consistent with discussions during Senate negotiations on the compromise, Commissioner Guess brings to the Commission a strong civil rights background. I am confident he will make an invaluable contribution to the Commission's work."
