## SENATOR DOLE MAKES NEW YEAR'S STATEMENT

WASHINGTON -- Kansas Senator Bob Dole today released the following statement for the coming New Year:

1983 proved to be a year of great promise for the nation's economy. It is my hope that, with strong leadership on both ends of Pennsylvania Avenue, and the support of the American people, the recovery can be strong and long-lived.

I've often said that the best farm program is a robust economy. With inflation down, we now need to attack the huge budget deficits which threaten to push interest rates up. Farmers will need to work closely in 1984 with Congress and their farm organizations to help meet the challenges facing America's most vital industry -- agriculture.

As we enter into the new year, all Americans will be praying for an end to the senseless acts of terrorism and violence that we have recently witnessed, and for a lasting, world-wide peace.
