## DOLE RECEIVES AG AWARD

WASHINGTON -- Kansas Senator Bob Dole has been honored as Agriculture Man of the Year by the Missouri-Kansas Chapter of the National Agri-Marketing Association.

The organization's 1985 Ag Day Award is given annually and recognizes the recipient's longstanding support and contribution to agriculture.

The Mo/Kan Chapter of the NAMA presented the award on March 15 by way of a special television satellite hook-up between Kansas City and Washington. Kansas City Mayor Richard L. Berkley made the presentation along with Ed Bible, the Chapter's president.

"I am tremendously honored by this award. Agriculture has been -- and always will be -- a top priority with me," Dole said. "1985 will be a challenging year for all of us on Capitol Hill who are vitally interested in shaping farm policy. As senior Republican on the Senate Agriculture Committee, the support of farm groups such as the NAMA back home will mean a lot to me as we work on the new farm bill."
