DOLE ANNOUNCES HELSINKI COMMISSION SELECTIONS

WASHINGTON -- Senate Majority Leader Bob Dole (R-Kans.) today announced his appointments to the Commission on Security and Cooperation in Europe, better known as the Helsinki Commission.

Yesterday, Senator Dole named Senator Alfonse D'Amato (R-N.Y.) Chairman of the Helsinki Commission, an 18 member House/Senate panel whose task it is to monitor compliance with the Helsinki Final Act of 1975 on human rights, military preparedness and arms control in Europe. There are 35 signatory nations to the Act, including the U.S. and U.S.S.R.
