WASHINGTON -- Senate Majority Leader Bob Dole and Speaker of the House Thomas P. "Tip" O'Neill will serve as Honorary Co-Chairmen for a Congressional Disability Awareness Reception on Wednesday, April 3, from 6-8 p.m. in Room 106 of the Dirksen Senate Office Building.
