## DOLE UNDERGOES MINOR SURGERY ON ELBOW

WASHINGTON -- Senate Majority Leader Bob Dole (R-KS) today underwent minor surgery on his right elbow. The hour-long procedure, performed by Col. Joseph Jackson, M.D., and Lt. Col. Dan Spielman, M.D., at Walter Reed Army Hospital was completely successful.

The operation involved the removal of a bone spur that was causing discomfort when pressure was applied. The bone spur was the result of Senator Dole's World War II injuries sustained in northern Italy. No general anesthetic was necessary and Senator Dole returned to full Senate duties a few hours after the early morning procedure.
