DOLE APPOINTS RUSSELL MILLS TO FEDERAL COUNCIL ON AGING

WASHINGTON -- Senate Majority Leader Bob Dole, R-Ks., today appointed Russell Mills to the Federal Council on Aging.

The Council was established to advise and assist the President on matters relating to the special needs of older Americans, and to review and evaluate federal policies regarding the aging.

An educator, Mills is the director of the Long Term Gerontology Center at the University of Kansas Medical Center. One of eleven centers in the United States, the mission of the Center is to improve the long-term care delivery system to the frail elderly.
