DOLE ISSUES NEW YEAR'S RESOLUTION

Kansas Senator Bob Dole, in offering his New Year's Resolution, gives priority to an improved economy in rural America in 1986.

The following is the text of Sen. Dole's resolution:

"As we ring in the New Year, let us be thankful for the freedoms we enjoy and the opportunities available to us. Let us resolve that these freedoms and opportunities will be grow, and be shared by all of our fellow citizens in the coming year.

"To this end, let us resolve to always remember the American farmer and his family, and all that they make available to us; to be sensitive to their sacrifices and to continue our efforts to bring hope and prosperity to rural America.

"Let us resolve to offer a helping hand to others in our communities less fortunate than ourselves; to share our bounty so that they too may live with a greater sense of purpose and with dignity.

"Let us resolve to redouble our commitment and efforts to make government more responsive and efficient; to reduce wasteful spending and the deficits which would burden future generations of Americans.

"Finally, let us resolve to bridge troubled waters wherever they exist in our world; to make impossible the nightmare of nuclear holocaust; to work for a lasting global peace."
