## DOLE PRAISES DECISION TO PUT WALDHEIM ON "WATCH LIST"

WASHINGTON -- SENATE REPUBLICAN LEADER BOB DOLE (R-KS.) TODAY PRAISED ATTORNEY GENERAL EDWIN MEESE III FOR PLACING KURT WALDHEIM ON THE SO-CALLED "WATCH LIST," MAKING ENTRY INTO THE UNITED STATES MORE DIFFICULT.

"Attorney General Meese and the Justice Department followed through in their obligation to investigate and decide how best to handle this delicate situation," Dole said. "The evidence to place Kurt Waldheim on a "watch list" was apparently compelling," Dole said.

"The timing of this decision, during National Holocaust Week, is more than fitting. It is a reminder that we must never forget the horror of the Holocaust, not if we cherish peace, freedom, and the dignity of man."
