### SENATOR DOLE'S PERSONAL INCOME TAX INFORMATION

WASHINGTON -- Senate Republican Leader Bob Dole (R-KS) today released information concerning his 1986 federal and state income tax returns. Dole noted that his income included a Senate salary of \$85,000, honoraria of \$119,575, income of \$40,000 from a daily nationwide radio show, and \$6,491 of interest income. Other items included rental income from his house in Russell, Kansas and an advance royalty payment for a Dole biography to be published early in 1988.

Once again, Senator Dole continued his policy of not accepting honoraria which might create the appearance of a conflict of interest either for himself or for his wife, Department of Transportation Secretary Elizabeth Dole. Therefore, of the \$119,575 of honoraria received, \$87,500, or 73.18%, was donated to charity. An itemized list of these charitable donations is attached.

Together, the Doles paid \$149,161 in income taxes for 1986, including \$133,856 in federal and \$15,305 in Kansas and North Carolina taxes. Joint 1986 income was higher than joint 1985 income principally as a result of the advance book royalties and trust capital gains.
