### NEW ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT NAMED BY SEN. DOLE

Washington, DC -- Kansas Senator Bob Dole has named Christina Bolton to serve as administrative assistant of his personal office in Washington, replacing Mike Pettit who leaves July 1 to become a consultant to Dole's presidential campaign.

Bolton has served as legislative director since 1985. In her new position she will be responsible for administration of the personal office which handles Kansas affairs. She will continue to direct legislative matters in her new capacity.

"I'm pleased that Chris has accepted this new challenge," said Sen. Dole in announcing the staff change. "She has always put Kansas first, and in her new position she'll continue to look for ways to help our state whenever and wherever possible.

"And I'm grateful to Mike for all he's done as my administrative assistant. He's made sure that the people in our state know Kansas comes first. I look forward to having him on the team, in another arena, in the months to come," said Sen. Dole.

Prior to joining Sen. Dole's staff in 1979, Bolton worked for the Georgetown University Medical Center and the Republican National Committee.

Pettit joined Sen. Dole's staff in 1981. He became staff director and chief counsel to Dole in 1983, and has been administrative assistant since 1985.
