## MOLITOR STREAK ENDS, DOLE'S BEGINS!

WASHINGTON -- ALTHOUGH PAUL MOLITOR'S AMAZING BATTING STREAK CAME TO AN END LAST NIGHT, ANOTHER STREAK BEGAN YESTERDAY AS SENATOR BOB DOLE'S SOFTBALL TEAM CLOBBERED AN INEXPERIENCED CREW FROM JACK KEMP'S OFFICE.
