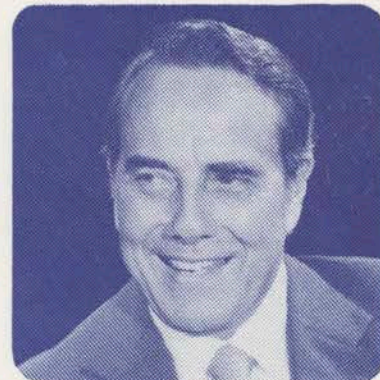

## DOLE ANNOUNCES FEDERAL HOUSING GRANTS FOR JUNCTION CITY

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senator Bob Dole (R-KS) today announced that the Junction City Housing Authority has been awarded two grants worth \$2,438,400 and \$660,960 respectively from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The grants will fund construction of 40 units of family housing and 18 units of housing for the elderly.

"I know these housing projects are much needed in Junction City, particularly housing suitable for families and facilities which meet the needs of the elderly," said Senator Dole. "I'm pleased that HUD has decided to provide the necessary funding."

The new family housing construction will consist of 25 three-bedroom units and 15 four-bedroom units. The sites of both projects have yet to be determined. Completion of the project is expected within the next year.
