DOLE ON BUSH CRIME PACKAGE: "AMERICA IS READY FOR TOUGH ACTION
--IS CONGRESS??" REPUBLICAN LEADER WILL FIGHT FOR BILL'S PASSAGE

WASHINGTON -- SENATE REPUBLICAN LEADER BOB DOLE (R-KS) TODAY ANNOUNCED "STRONG SUPPORT" FOR PRESIDENT GEORGE BUSH'S NEW ANTI-CRIME PACKAGE AND SAID HE WILL "FIGHT FOR THE BILL'S PASSAGE."

"AMERICA IS FED-UP AND READY FOR TOUGH ACTION, BUT WHAT ABOUT CONGRESS? AFTER WATCHING LAWMAKERS REPEATEDLY REJECT ALMOST EVERY EFFORT TO CRACKDOWN ON CRIME, I WOULDN'T BE SURPRISED IF SOME PEOPLE ARE SKEPTICAL," DOLE SAID. "I HOPE THAT EVERY AMERICAN WHO IS FED-UP WITH THE DRUG AND CRIME NIGHTMARE WILL BE WATCHING US EVERY STEP OF THE WAY SO THEY CAN FIND OUT WHO IS SERIOUS ABOUT NAILING THE THUGS, THE MURDERERS AND THE PUSHERS."

"THE PRESIDENT'S PACKAGE SPEAKS FOR AMERICA: LET'S PUT THE CLAMPS ON GUN-TOTING, DRUG-PUSHING CRIMINALS. LET'S CONVICT THEM AND LET'S LOCK THEM UP," DOLE SAID.
