\$5.2 MILLION & TRANSFER OF BUILDING OWNERSHIP TO GEARY COUNTY
Caps 20-year effort to improve Ft. Riley Junior High School

WASHINGTON -- ATTENTION NEWS DIRECTORS AND EDITORS:

Senators Bob Dole and Nancy Kassebaum will be joined by Dan Bonner, Acting Assistant Secretary of Education for Elementary and Secondary Education, and Mary Devin, Geary County, KS., Deputy School Superintendent at a signing ceremony on Wednesday, October 4, at 3:00 p.m. in Senator Dole's office, Room S-230 of the U.S. Capitol.

The ceremony will mark the culmination of a 20-year effort to improve conditions at Ft. Riley Schools. The papers, to be signed, notarized and witnessed, will transfer title of six buildings at Ft. Riley to the Geary County Unified School District and \$5.2 million in federal funds to renovate the buildings.

Following the ceremony, the senators, education, and local officials will be available for questions.

Joining Deputy Superintendent Mary Devin will be Max Heim, Superintendent of the Geary County Schools; Wade Anderson, Business Manager; and Mark Edwards, President, Board of Education.
