KANSAS WOMAN RECEIVES PRESIDENTIAL APPOINTMENT
AT THE REQUEST OF SENATOR BOB DOLE

WASHINGTON -- Republican Leader Bob Dole (R-KS) today applauded the appointment of Esther Levens of Prarie Village, Kansas, to the United States Holocaust Memorial Council. The appointment was officially made today by President Bush.

"Esther Levens is one of the real giants of the Jewish community in Kansas. She's been a longtime leader and a dedicated supporter of the Holocaust Memorial. The President has made Kansas proud and I'm pleased he has recognized Esther's talents. She will be a welcome addition to the Holocaust Memorial Council".

The U.S. Holocaust Memorial Council, created by Public Law 97-84, provides for appropriate ways to commemorate the Days of Remembrance and national and civil commemoration of the holocaust.

The Council encourages and sponsors appropriate observances of such Days of Remembrance throughout the United States. Additionally, the Council has been active in overseeing the construction of a permanent living memorial museum, to be located near the Mall in Washington, D.C.
