### DOLE SELECTS 51 FOR ACADEMY NOMINATIONS

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Kansas Senator Bob Dole has selected 51 young Kansans as 1991 nominees to compete for appointments to the United States Air Force Academy, Merchant Marine Academy, Military Academy, and Naval Academy.

"These young men and women have demonstrated superior academic preparation and leadership qualities. At a time when our nation's armed forces are gallantly meeting the challenges in the Middle East, the drive of these young people adds to the mood of the nation. Kansas can be proud of these youth. The class of 1995 has my best wishes for continued success," said Dole.

In addition to the nominees named by Senator Dole, several other highly qualified candidates have already been offered admission through other sources. To avoid unnecessary duplication, those individuals were not included on Senator Dole's list.

Using the competitive method of nomination, Senator Dole selects a slate of ten individuals for each vacancy he intends to fill. As the final step in the process, each academy then evaluates the candidates and offers an appointment.

The nomination process begins in the fall, usually during the senior year of high school. At that time, those interested should contact Senator Dole and each academy admissions office for application materials. The deadline for submitting the completed forms is early December.
