## **HAYDEN CONFIRMED**

WASHINGTON -- THE NOMINATION OF FORMER KANSAS GOVERNOR MIKE HAYDEN TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR CLEARED THE SENATE BY UNANIMOUS CONSENT, ACCORDING TO SENATE REPUBLICAN LEADER BOB DOLE. HAYDEN WILL BE THE NEW ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF THE INTERIOR FOR FISH, WILDLIFE AND PARKS.

"I AM PLEASED MIKE'S NOMINATION WENT SO SMOOTHLY ON CAPITOL HILL, FROM COMMITTEE REVIEW TO UNANIMOUS SENATE PASSAGE TODAY.
