DOLE: IOLA AIRPORT TO RECEIVE 1.5 MILLION

WASHINGTON - KANSAS SENATOR BOB DOLE ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT THE ALLEN COUNTY AIRPORT, IOLA, WILL RECEIVE \$1,516,011 FOR AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS. THE FUNDING COMES FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION, A DIVISION OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

"ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INCREASINGLY DEPENDS ON QUALITY AIR SERVICE. THIS IS PARTICULARLY IMPORTANT IN RURAL AREAS, WHERE ACCESS TO MARKETS IS VITAL TO MAINTAINING A COMMUNITY'S ECONOMIC LIFELINE. I AM PLEASED THAT SECRETARY SKINNER RECOGNIZES KANSAS AVIATION NEEDS," SAID DOLE.

THE FUNDING WILL BE USED TO CONSTRUCT AND LIGHT A NEW RUNWAY AND TO INSTALL VISUAL APPROACH AIDS.

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
