DOLE REPORTS FINAL ACTION AS \$2.1 MILLION IN TORNADO RELIEF
HEADS TO KANSAS;

WASHINGTON - "It's a done deal -- Kansas doesn't have to wait for any supplemental bill from Congress now that \$2.1 million in federal disaster assistance is on its way to Kansas communities hit by the April 26th tornados," Kansas Senator Bob Dole announced today. Dole received a call this morning from Wallace Stickney, Director of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) informing him of the good news.

The Kansas disaster assistance funding provision, secured by Senator Dole October 7, 1991, is included in the FY1992 VA\HUD Appropriations bill that President Bush signed October 28, 1991.

"This is great news for the Kansas communities damaged by the devastating tornados last spring. We've been pushing for this aid for a long time, and now work can begin on repairing the damaged roads and public buildings. This will put cash into the communities that need it the most," said Dole.

Last month, Dole secured assurances from senior officials of the Office of Management and Budget, (OMB) and FEMA after meeting to discuss Dole's proposal. Originally, the funding was part of the President's emergency supplemental appropriations request, which had become bogged down in the House of Representatives. At Dole's request, funding was included in the VA\HUD appropriations bill, which had already received final approval from both Houses of Congress.
