**DOLE NAMES KELLY TO EDUCATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

WASHINGTON - Senate Majority Leader Bob Dole announced today that the U.S. Senate has approved his recommendation of Dr. Robert N. Kelly of Topeka to the Department of Education's Advisory Committee on Student Financial Assistance.

"Bob's experience and extensive knowledge of student financial assistance on both the national and state level make him a solid choice for the Committee," said Dole. "He has a strong interest in fostering effective and efficient federal student aid programs, and in bringing fiscal responsibility to education policy."

Since 1976, Dr. Kelly has served as Executive Director of the Kansas Independent College Association which represents eighteen independent colleges before governmental agencies and the state legislature and coordinates college financial aid programs and admission activities.

The Advisory Committee on Student Financial Assistance is an independent panel comprised of 11 members from the private sector who advise the Secretary of Education and Congress on student financial aid.

Senator Kassebaum has strongly backed Kelly for this appointment.
