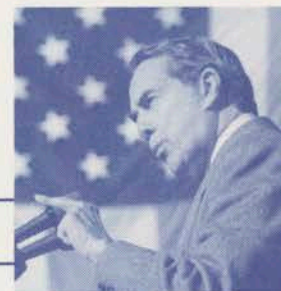

DOLE SUPPORT OF LINCOLN INDUSTRIAL PARK  
WINS SENATE APPROVAL

WASHINGTON - Kansas Senator Bob Dole's support of a grant application by Lincoln, Kansas, for an industrial park was included in legislation approved in the U.S. Senate today. The language ensures that Lincoln is included in the list of applicants recommended for USDA grants, which fund the construction of industrial facilities in rural areas.

"Local residents have worked hard to prepare and to promote Lincoln, and it is clearly an ideal candidate for this rural development project," Dole said. "This language allows Lincoln to compete for a grant, which would immediately produce jobs and diversify the economy. The proposed facility also holds the potential for further expansion in the future."

The language, also supported by Senator Nancy Kassebaum, is included in the 1996 Agriculture Appropriations Bill, which now goes to a joint House/Senate committee to work out differences with legislation passed in the House.
