- VIETNAM RESOLUTION -

ON OCTOBER 13, I INTRODUCED A RESOLUTION IN THE SENATE DEALING WITH THE VIETNAM WAR. OF COURSE, VIETNAM RESOLUTIONS HAVE NOT BEEN UNCOMMON IN WASHINGTON THIS YEAR. MY RESOLUTION WAS JUST A BIT DIFFERENT FROM THE GENERAL RUN OF RESOLUTIONS, HOWEVER, IT DID NOT IMPLORE THE UNITED STATES TO GET OUT OF VIETNAM, OR CASTIGATE THE SOUTH VIETNAMESE FOR ONE DEFICIENCY OR ANOTHER. IT DID NOT SEEK TO IMPOSE TIMETABLES OR SET POLICY. INSTEAD OF EXPRESSING THESE IDEAS, MY RESOLUTION CALLED ON HANOI AND THE VIETCONG TO TAKE CERTAIN REASONABLE, POSITIVE STEPS TOWARD ACHIEVING A JUST AND LASTING PEACE THROUGH THE NEGOTIATIONS AT PARIS. THIS RESOLUTION ALSO HAD THE CO-SPONSORSHIP OF 35 OF MY COLLEAGUES -- INCLUDING, I AM PROUD TO SAY, PAUL FANNIN AND BARRY GOLDWATER.

- GEOGRAPHICAL CONCENTRATION -

HE SPOKE OF THE HANDFUL OF MEN WHO DETERMINE THE CONTENT OF THE NIGHTLY NETWORK NEWS BROADCASTS. AND YOU ALL KNOW THE COMMOTION THAT FOLLOWED. IT WAS INTERESTING THAT THESE SAME IDEAS HAD BEEN EXPRESSED SEVERAL WEEKS EARLIER IN A CONVERSATION BETWEEN THEODORE WHITE, AUTHOR OF THE MAKING OF THE PRESIDENT 1968, AND WILLIAM F. BUCKLEY, JR. IT WAS POINTED OUT AND AGREED UPON BY BOTH MEN THAT WITHIN A FEW SQUARE BLOCKS ON MANHATTAN ISLAND THERE WAS A CONCENTRATION OF NOT ONLY THE ELECTRONIC MEDIA, BUT ALSO OF THE PRINTED SOURCES SUPPLYING NEWS AND OPINION TO PERHAPS 90% OF THE AMERICAN PUBLIC. THAT THESE SOURCES COVERED SUCH POLITICAL

THE PEOPLE WHO WORK FOR THESE PUBLICATIONS AND THE NETWORKS,
WHO SIFT AND SORT THE NEWS ARE ENGAGED IN NO GREAT CONSPIRACY TO
MOLD THE MINDS OF THE AMERICAN PEOPLE. BUT THEY, LIKE OURSELVES
ARE SHAPED BY THEIR ENVIRONMENT AND THE PEOPLE AROUND THEM. THEY
DO NOT GATHER IN SINISTER CELLS TO PLOT THE NEWS EVENTS TO BE
COVERED AND THE COLORING TO BE GIVEN THEM. BUT THEY LIVE IN THE
SAME NEW YORK MEGALOPOLIS. THEY RIDE THE SAME COMMUTER TRAINS
TO AND FROM WORK. THEY HAVE BASICALLY THE SAME NEWS SOURCES.
THEY ARE ONLY HUMAN AND WITH NO INTENTION OF BEING PAROCHIAL
MYSELF, I WOULD POINT OUT THAT NEW YORK HAS A REPUTATION, FOR
ALL ITS SOPHISTICATION AND MODERNITY, A HIGHLY PROVINCIAL AND
INWARD-LOOKING VIEWPOINT IN MANY FIELDS. THE ATMOSPHERE

SURROUNDING THESE NEWSMEN, TELEVISION PRODUCERS, AND COMMENTATORS
IS BOUND TO AFFECT THEM IN SUBTLE AND QUIET WAYS.

- RAISING QUESTIONS -

I DO NOT WISH TO ADD FUEL TO ANY CONTROVERSY, BUT I WOULD,
AS THE VICE PRESIDENT, LIKE TO RAISE SOME QUESTIONS. I AM CALLING
NO INDIVIDUALS OR ORGANIZATIONS TO TASK. BUT I FEEL THAT SOME
PUBLIC QUESTIONING WOULD BE BENEFICIAL TO THE PUBLIC INTEREST
AS WELL AS TO THE MEDIA. ABOVE ALL, I DO NOT WANT TO MAKE EVEN
THE SLIGHTEST SUGGESTION THAT ANY FORM OF CENSORSHIP SHOULD BE
EMPLOYED. BUT AS VICE PRESIDENT AGNEW SAID THURSDAY EVENING THE
MEDIA SHOULD BE CALLED UPON TO ENJOY THE "ROUGH AND TUMBLE" OF
OUR FIRST AMENDMENT'S GREAT RIGHT.

POLITICANS HAVE NEVER HAD THEIR PRONOUNCEMENTS AND PONTIFI-
CATIONS ACCEPTED OR ACQUIESCED IN WITHOUT SCRUTINY AND COMMENT
FROM THEIR FELLOWS IN THE POLITICAL ARENA. AND FORTUNATELY FOR

ALL OF US THE COMMENTATORS OF THE PRESS, RADIO AND TELEVISION
HAVE NEVER BEEN RELUCTANT TO ADD THEIR OBSERVATIONS.

I FEEL IT IS APPROPRIATE TO ASK THE MEMBERS OF THE MEDIA, WITH
THE SAME VIGOR AND ALACRITY WHICH WE EMPLOY WITH OUR FELLOW
POLITICANS, TO ANSWER FOR THEIR OPINIONS AND POSITIONS. I HAVE
NO FEARS FOR THE WELFARE OF THESE DEDICATED AND CONSCIENTIOUS
REPORTERS, EDITORS AND COMMENTATORS. THEY HAVE DISHED IT OUT
FOR A LONG TIME, AND THEY CAN SURELY TAKE IT.

FRESH, REALISTIC APPROACHES ARE BEING TAKEN TOWARD THE PROBLEMS WHICH THE DEMOCRATS SPENT EIGHT YEARS CREATING AND WORSENING. POLICY FORMULATION. THESE PRESSURES HAVE COME FROM ALL AREAS OF
THE POLITICAL AND IDEOLOGICAL SPECTRUM -- HAWKS AND DOVES, LIBERALS
AND CONSERVATIVES. TO HIS GREAT CREDIT PRESIDENT NIXON HAS RESISTED
THE EXTREMES URGED UPON HIM; HE HAS PAINSTAKINGLY EXAMINED THE
ALTERNATIVES AND THEIR CONSEQUENCES; AND HE HAS DEVISED A SENSIBLE,
