IT IS A PLEASURE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE 1970 CONVENTION OF THE KANSAS STATE ASSOCIATION OF LIFE UNDERWRITERS.

TONIGHT I WANT TO DISCUSS A SUBJECT ABOUT WHICH ALL AMERICANS ARE CONCERNED DAILY: THE QUALITY OF OUR LIVES.

ENVIRONMENT

THE QUALITY OF OUR PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT HAS BECOME THE MOST POPULAR CONNOTATION OF THAT PHRASE. WE HAVE REACHED THE POINT IN THE DEGRADATION OF OUR WORLD WHEN ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS MUST BECOME CENTRAL COMPONENTS OF EVERY DECISION WE MAKE --- PUBLIC, PRIVATE, COLLECTIVE, OR INDIVIDUAL.

THE PRESIDENT, IN HIS FIRST STATE OF THE UNION ADDRESS, EXPRESSED THIS CONCERN:

"THE GREAT QUESTION OF THE SEVENTIES IS SHALL WE SURRENDER TO OUR SURROUNDINGS, OR SHALL WE MAKE OUR PEACE WITH NATURE AND BEGIN TO MAKE REPARATIONS FOR THE DAMAGE WE HAVE DONE TO OUR AIR, TO OUR LAND, AND TO OUR WATER."

WHAT CAN WE DO?

WE HAVE IDENTIFIED THE PROBLEM AND THE NEXT QUESTION IS:
WHAT CAN WE AS INDIVIDUALS AND AS A SOCIETY DO ABOUT IT? I COULD
ANSWER THAT QUESTION BY DISCUSSING PRESIDENT NIXON'S ENVIRONMENTAL
PACKAGE WHICH IS PRESENTLY THE SUBJECT OF CONGRESSIONAL HEARINGS.
BUT THAT IS NOT MY INTENTION TONIGHT. INSTEAD I WOULD RATHER MAKE
SOME MORE GENERAL OBSERVATIONS AND POSE FURTHER QUESTIONS --- TO
STIMULATE, AND I HOPE, TO PROVOKE.

SIZE OF THE PROBLEM

MY FIRST OBSERVATION IS CENTRAL TO ALL THE REST: THE PROBLEM
IS TOO BIG FOR ANY ONE COMPONENT OF OUR SOCIETY TO SOLVE ALONE. WE ARE
ALL POLLUTORS, AND THE BETTER WE LIVE THE MORE WE POLLUTE. ALL OF OUR
ENVIRONMENTAL PROBLEMS ARE INTERRELATED ---- BEGINNING WITH PEOPLE, IN
BOTH NUMBERS AND DISTRIBUTION, AND INCLUDING AIR AND WATER AND WASTE,
FOODS AND DRUGS, URBAN CONCENTRATION AND SUBURBAN SPRAWL IN THE SEVENTIES.

IT IS PERFECTLY CLEAR, FOR EXAMPLE, THAT THERE IS NOT ONE PROBLEM OF AUTOMOTIVE AIR POLLUTION AND ONE PROBLEM OF STATIONARY SOURCE AIR POLLUTION ---- THERE IS A COMPREHENSIVE PROBLEM OF AIR QUALITY.

UNLESS INDUSTRY BEGINS TO CALCULATE THE SOCIAL COSTS OF POL-LUTION -- THE BY-PRODUCTS OF THE TECHNIQUES OF PRODUCTION -- AND REFLECTS THEM IN THE PRICE OF THE PRODUCT, THERE WILL BE NO ACCURATE WAY TO MEASURE THESE COSTS. UNLESS THE GOVERNMENT BECOMES MORE CONSCIOUS OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS OF ITS TAX, LAND-USE, SUBSIDIES, AND RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS, IT WILL CONTINUE TO PLAY "CATCH-UP" WITH A HIGHER AND
HIGHER PRICE-TAG.

UNLESS THE AMERICAN PEOPLE ARE PREPARED TO PAY THE COSTS OF ENVIRONMENTAL RESTORATION -- COSTS THAT MAY RANGE FROM LESS POWERFUL AUTOS TO LESS FREQUENTLY OCCUPIED BASSINETS -- NO POLITICAL AUTHORITY CAN COMPLETELY PREVENT ENVIRONMENTAL DEGRADATION.

COMPLEXITY OF PROBLEM

MY SECOND OBSERVATION IS TO RATE THE COMPLEXITY OF THE PROBLEM.

COMPARATIVELY SPEAKING, A MOON SHOT IS EASY. ALL IT TAKES IS THE TECH
NOLOGY AND DOLLARS AND THE COMMAND DECISION TO HARNESS THEM INTO ONE

MASSIVE EFFORT. AND THE MEASURE OF SUCCESS, WHICH WAS JEOPARDIZED IN

APOLLO 13 BECAUSE OF A MECHANICAL FAILURE, IS LAUNCH TOUCH DOWN, AND SAFE RETURN.

IN THE ENVIRONMENTAL ARENA, POLITICAL, ECONOMIC, AND SOCIAL FACTORS ARE ALL INTERMESHED -- AS ARE HUMAN CHOICES AND COMPETING INTERESTS.

THE COMPLEXITY RANGES FAR BEYOND STREETS AND CITIES CLEAR OF DEBRIS OR TAKING THE LEAD OUT OF GASOLINE. IT EMBRACES COMMITMENT TO COLLECTIVE ACTION. IT INVOLVES THE NECESSITY TO DEVELOP ABILITY TO PREDICT THE ENVIRONMENTAL EFFECTS OF TECHNOLOGICAL DEVELOPMENTS.

SEVENTY-FIVE YEARS AGO, WHO COULD HAVE PREDICTED THAT THE
INVENTION OF THE INTERNAL COMBUSTION ENGINE WOULD LEAD TO THE RADICAL
SHIFTS IN LIFE-STYLE SYMBOLIZED BY THE SUBURB AND THE SHOPPING CENTER -let alone threaten the life-SUSTAINING CARBON-OXYGEN CYCLE OF THE UPPER

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ATMOSPHERE? OR, IF THERE HAD BEEN SUCH PREDICTIONS, WHO WOULD HAVE BELIEVED THEM?

NEED FOR PERMANENT MACHINERY

MY THIRD GENERAL OBSERVATION IS THAT WE MUST BEGIN NOW TO TRANSLATE OUR PRESENT CONCERN INTO PERMANENT MACHINERY. THIS MEANSWNEW LAWS, ALTERATIONS IN THE MARKET MECHANISM, INSTITUTIONAL RESTRUCTURING AND TRANSFORMED DECISION MAKING PROCESSES. IT MEANS, IN SHORT, THE CREATION OF A FRAMEWORK THAT WILL CONTINUE TO EXIST DESPITE THE VAGARIES OF PUBLIC ATTENTION.

WE ALL ARE TO BLAME

ONE FINAL OBSERVATION ABOUT THE QUEST FOR ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY: THIS IS NOT AN ISSUE THAT WE CAN AFFORD TO LET FALL PREY TO DEMONOLOGIES, OR CONSPIRACY THEORIES. AS THE PRESIDENT SAID IN HIS ENVIRONMENTAL MESSAGE:

"THE DAMAGE DONE TO OUR ENVIRONMENT HAS NOT BEEN
THE WORK OF EVIL MEN, NOR HAS IT BEEN THE INEVIF
TABLE BY-PRODUCT EITHER OF ADVANCING TECHNOLOGY
OR OF GROWING POPULATION. IT RESULTS NOT FROM
CHOICES MADE, OR FROM CHOICES NEGLECTED; NOT
FROM MALIGN INTENTION, BUT FROM FAILURE TO TAKE
INTO ACCOUNT THE FULL CONSEQUENCES OF OUR ACTIONS"
ENVIRONMENTAL DEGRADATION IS A PRODUCT OF OUR CULTURE. IT

ARISES OUT OF ATTITUDES SHARED BY NEARLY EVERYONE AND IS BEST ILLUSTRATED BY THE WESTWARD MOVEMENT: CONSUME, EXHAUST AVAILABLE RESOURCES AND
MOVE ON TO VIRGIN LAND. BUT TODAY WE CANNOT GO WEST AND FIND VIRGIN LAND.
WHAT IS REQUIRED IS NOT GOING TO BE CHEAP -- NOT IN TERMS OF DOLLARS -NOT IN TERMS OF INTERESTS THAT MUST BE SACRIFICED. THERE ARE GOING TO
HAVE TO BE TRADE-OFFS. INTERESTS AND CONVENIENCES MUST BE BALANCED
ONE AGAINST ANOTHER -- AND ALL OF THEM AGAINST THE CONTINUATION OF LIFE
ON THIS PLANET.

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CRIME

NOW, I WOULD LIKE TO TURN TO ANOTHER FACTOR WHICH HAS A SIGNIFICANT IMPACT ON THE QUALITY OF OUR LIVES. IT IS NOT AIR OR WATER POLLUTION, BUT CRIMINAL POLLUTION, AND IT ERODES OUR COMMERCIAL AND PRIVATE LIVES

JUST AS RAW SEWAGE AND BELCHING SMOKESTACKS DO OUR NATURAL RESOURCES.

MANY BELIEVE THAT CRIME IS ONLY THE MAFIA OR HOODLUM GANGS. THIS IS NOT SO.

MANY AMERICANS ALSO THINK OF CRIME AS A VERY NARROW RANGE OF BEHAVIOR. IT IS NOT. AN ENORMOUS VARIETY OF ACTIVITIES MAKE UP OUR "CRIME
PROBLEM". CRIME IS NOT JUST A TOUGH TEENAGER SNATCHING A LADY'S PURSE;
IT IS A PROFESSIONAL THIEF STEALING CARS "TO ORDER". IT IS NOT ONLY A
WELL-HEELED LOAN SHARK TAKING OVER A LEGITIMATE BUSINESS FOR ORGANIZED
CRIME; IT IS A CORPORATION EXECUTIVE CONSPIRING WITH COMPETITORS TO FIX
PRICES. THERE IS NO SINGLE FORMULA -- NO SINGLE THEORY OR GENERALIZATION
THAT CAN DESCRIBE THE VAST RANGE OF BEHAVIOR CALLED CRIME, OR THOSE WHO
COMMIT IT.

THE TASK OF CONTROLLING CRIME -- WHO IS RESPONSIBLE?

MANY AMERICANS BELIEVE THAT CONTROLLING CRIME IS SOLELY
THE TASK OF THE POLICE, THE COURTS, AND THE CORRECTION AGENCIES.
THE FACT IS THAT CRIME CANNOT BE CONTROLLED WITHOUT PUBLIC INTEREST
AND INVOLVEMENT. STATES AND COMMUNITIES ACROSS THE COUNTRY MUST
JOIN WITH THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT IN COMBATING CRIME.

SIGNIFICANT REDUCTION IN CRIME POSSIBLE

DESPITE THE SERIOUSNESS OF THE PROBLEM TODAY, I BELIEVE
THAT A SIGNIFICANT REDUCTION IN CRIME IS POSSIBLE IF THE FOLLOWING
OBJECTIVES ARE VIGOROUSLY PURSUED.

FIRST, SOCIETY MUST SEEK TO PREVENT CRIME BEFORE IT HAPPENS BY ASSURING ALL AMERICANS A STAKE IN THE BENEFITS AND
RESPONSIBILITIES OF AMERICAN LIFE, BY STRENGTHENING LAW ENFORCEMENT,
AND BY REDUCING CRIMINAL OPPORTUNITIES. THE NIXON ADMINISTRATION
HAS UNDERTAKEN DEFINITE ACTION IN THIS DIRECTION, INCLUDING AN
EFFORT TO DISCOVER HOW OUR COURTS CAN BEST SPEED THE ADMINISTRATION
OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE.

SERVED IF THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM DEVELOPED A FAR BROADER
RANGE OF TECHHIQUES WITH WHICH TO DEAL WITH INDIVIDUAL OFFENDERS.
FOR INSTANCE, EVERY COMMUNITY SHOULD CONSIDER ESTABLISHING A YOUTH
SERVICES BUREAU -- A COMMUNITY-BASED CENTER TO WHICH JUVENILES
THEMSELVES COULD TURN OR BE REFERRED BY THE POLICE, THE COURTS,
PARENTS, SCHOOLS, AND SOCIAL AGENCIES FOR COUNSELING, EDUCATION,
WORK OR RECREATION PROGRAMS, AND JOB PLACEMENT.

THIRD, OUR CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM MUST ATTRACT MORE

AND BETTER PEOPLE -- POLICE, PROSECUTORS, JUDGES, DEFENSE

ATTORNEYS, PROBATION AND PAROLE OFFICERS, AND CORRECTIONS OFFICIALS

WITH INCREASED KNOWLEDGE, EXPERTISE, INITIATIVE, AND UNQUESTIONED

INTEGRITY. AS WITH THE ENVIRONMENT, INDIVIDUAL INITIATIVE IS THE

SUREST CATALYST FOR SOLUTIONS TO THE PROBLEMS AT HAND. THE ATTRACTION

OF QUALITY PERSONNEL TO THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM IS VITAL TO

FUTURE PROGRESS.

FOURTH, LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES, COURTS, AND CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS SHOULD BE PROVIDED WITH EXPANDED FINANCIAL RESOURCES FOR FACILITIES, EQUIPMENT AND PERSONNEL.

FINALLY, INDIVIDUALS, CIVIC AND BUSINESS ORGANIZATIONS,
RELIGIOUS INSTITUTIONS, AND ALL LEVELS OF GOVERNMENT MUST SUPPORT
AND EMPHASIZE THE NEED FOR PROGRESSIVE AND FUNDAMENTAL CHANGES
IN PUBLIC ATTITUDES TOWARD THE ROLE OF THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM.

RESPECT FOR THE JUDICIAL SYSTEM

ONE POINT ABOUT OUR JUDICIAL SYSTEM DOES NOT CALL FOR CHANGE -IN FACT, THE NEED IS TO STRENGTHEN AND FORTIFY FUNDAMENTAL ATTITUDES.

I AM SPEAKING OF RESPECT FOR THE JUDICIAL SYSTEM AND RECOGNITION OF ITS
AUTHORITY AS THE CORNERSTONE OF OUR RIGHTS AND LIBERTIES. THIS SYSTEM
HAS RECENTLY BEEN SUBJECTED TO A FRONTAL ASSAULT UNPRECEDENTED IN OUR
HISTORY.

JUDICIAL SYSTEM

AT THE TRIALS OF THE CHICAGO SEVEN, THE D.C. NINE, AND THE 13
BLACK PANTHERS IN NEW YORK CITY, ATTEMPTS WERE MADE TO DISRUPT THE PROCEDURES WHICH HAVE BEEN THE FIRMEST BASTION OF INDIVIDUAL RIGHTS. OUR
COURTS BECAME NOT SANCTUARIES OF DISPASSIONATE REASON, BUT CENTERS OF
EMOTIONAL DEMONSTRATION. THE RULE OF PERSUASION WAS ABANDONED FOR A
STRATEGY OF INTIMIDATION.

MY CONCERN IS NOT WITH THESE PARTICULAR TRIALS -- IT IS RATHER WITH THE EFFECT THAT SUCH DISRUPTION HAS ON THE ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE.

ANCES TO PROGRESS FROM SAVAGE RETALIATION TO ORDERLY JURISPRUDENCE, THE DANGER BECOMES APPARENT. FIVE MILLION YEARS OF EVOLUTION PRECEDED THE PRESENT STATE OF CIVILIZATION. BARELY 2500 YEARS HAVE PASSED SINCE THE EARLY LAWS OF MOSES AND HAMURABI ESTABLISHED THE FOUNDATIONS OF JUSTICE. ONLY SEVEN CENTURIES AGO, THE MAGNA CARTA SET FORTH THE PRINCIPLE THAT A NATION AND ITS LEADERS WOULD "DENY JUSTICE TO NONE, NOR DELAY IT."

THOSE WHO CONDEMN CIVILIZATION FOR NOT MOVING FAST ENOUGH ARE WRONG. AT THE SAME TIME THOSE WHO WOULD BE COMPLACENT ARE EQUALLY WRONG. NAZI GERMANY, COMMUNIST CHINA OR CASTRO'S CUBA PROVE THAT TEN CENTURIES OF CIVILIZED PROGRESS CAN BE HALTED OVERNIGHT.

THE SUPREME COURT'S UNANIMOUS DECISION LAST MONTH REAFFIRMED
THE PRINCIPLE THAT THE TACTICS OF DISRUPTION AND CONFRONTATION HAVE
NO PLACE IN THE CHAMBERS OF JUSTICE. MR. JUSTICE BLACK STATED IN HIS
OPINION:

"IT WOULD DEGRADE OUR COUNTRY AND OUR JUDICIAL SYSTEM TO PERMIT OUR COURTS TO BE BULLIED, INSULTED, AND THEIR ORDERLY PROGRESS THWARTED AND OBSTRUCTED BY DEFENDENTS BROUGHT BEFORE THEM CHARGED WITH CRIMES."

OURS IS A GOVERNMENT OF LAWS, NOT MEN. INTERFERENCE WITH THE ADMINISTRA-TION OF JUSTICE JEOPARDIZES THE SECURITY OF EACH CITIZEN.

THE FOUNDING FATHERS PROPOSED A POSITIVE SYSTEM OF GOVERNMENT

---- THE MOST SUPERB SOCIAL ORGANIZATION IN HUMAN HISTORY. TODAY'S RADICAL THOUGHT IS SOLELY NEGATIVE AND NIHILISTIC IN CONTENT.

THOSE WHO ADVOCATE REVOLUTION AND THOSE WHO ENCOURAGE THEM

PERVERT OUR NATIONAL IDEALS, AND IF WE ROMANTICIZE THESE REVOLUTION—

ARIES, WE NEGATE THE EFFORTS OF RESPONSIBLE CITIZENS. CAPITULATION

BEFORE THEIR TERRORISTIC TACTICS WOULD REND THE FABRIC OF OUR FREEDOM.

WE STAND AT AN EXTRAORDINARY MOMENT IN OUR NATION'S HISTORY -A MOMENT WHICH DEMANDS NOBILITY FROM ALL MEN.

WE ARE CHALLENGED TO EXERCISE CALM IN THE FACE OF MORAL OUT-RAGE. WE MUST ENFORCE THE LAW WITH EQUINAMITY AND DISREGARD THE PROVO-CATIONOF PASSION.

THE MONTHS AND YEARS AHEAD WILL NOT BE EASY. BUT NO ONE HAS EVER SAID THAT FREEDOM WAS EASILY WON OR HELD.
