CO-HOSTING THIS SPECIAL BREAKFAST WITH MY COLLEAGUE JIM WRIGHT.

THERE ARE A LOT OF CLICHES ABOUT HOW THE YOUTH OF A NATION IS
ITS FUTURE. BUT IT JUST SO HAPPENS THAT THIS CLICHE IS A VALID
ONE.

AS A SENATOR, I FEEL AN OVERRIDING OBLIGATION TO WORK TO SEE
TO IT THAT THE STATE OF THE NATION IS HEALTHY -- ITS ECONOMY, ITS
SECURITY, ITS SENSE OF JUSTICE, WHEN MY GENERATION HANDS THE
REIGNS OVER TO YOURS.

THAT'S NOT EASY THESE DAYS. IT'S A COMPLEX WORLD WITH
PROBLEMS THAT PRESENT NO EASY ANSWERS. BUT WE'RE TRYING --
WHETHER ITS TO CUT THE DEFICIT OR SIMPLIFY THE TAX SYSTEM -- BEEF
UP OUR NATIONAL DEFENSE SO ITS SECOND TO NONE -- OR COMBAT THE
USE AND ABUSE OF DRUGS -- CONGRESS IS GRAPPLING WITH THE BIG
ISSUES -- GRAPPLING WITH YOU IN MIND.
