The main interest is in your views on how the tax reform process will finally play out (i.e., as the bill is fully implemented over the next two years); and on any additional tax changes (technical corrections or otherwise) that you see as likely in the 100th Congress. In addition, they would appreciate any comments you can make on the course of the economy over the next few years.
