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ABRAHAM LINCOLN WON ELECTION TO THE ILLINOIS GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT THE AGE OF 25.

TEDDY ROOSEVELT WAS 24 WHEN HE WON A SEAT IN THE NEW YORK ASSEMBLY.

AND I WON MY FIRST TERM IN THE KANSAS LEGISLATURE AT THE AGE OF 26 AND I INTEND TO INTEND TO FOLLOW THE TRADITION OF LINCOLN AND TR AND MAKE MY NEXT ELECTIVE OFFICE THE OVAL OFFICE.

I WANT TO THANK GEORGE MICKELSON AND LARRY PRESSLER FOR THEIR UNFLAGGING SUPPORT FROM THE EARLIEST DAYS OF MY CAMPAIGN. AND ELIZABETH, ROBIN AND I ARE GRATEFUL FOR THE COUNTLESS KINDNESSES THAT HAVE BEEN BEEN EXTENDED TO US BY SOUTH DAKOTANS DURING THE MANY VISITS WE HAVE MADE HERE IN RECENT MONTHS. OF COURSE, A PRIMARY VICTORY ON FEBRUARY 23 WILL BE OUR BEST MEMORY OF YOUR STATE, BUT JUST AS MEMORABLE WILL BE THE MANY NEW FRIENDSHIPS WE HAVE MADE HERE.

THREE MONTHS AGO, WHEN THIS CAMPAIGN FORMALLY BEGAN IN MY HOME TOWN OF RUSSELL, KANSAS, I SAID I WANTED TO LEAD AMERICA INTO AN EVEN GREATER ERA OF OPPORTUNITY FOR OUR PEOPLE AND SECURITY FOR OUR NATION. I OFFERED A

WILLINGNESS TO WORK HARD, TO HANG TOUGH, TO GO THE
DISTANCE. AND I OFFERED THE STRENGTH AND DETERMINATION TO
BRING COMMON-SENSE ANSWERS TO THE COMPLEX PROBLEMS FACING
AMERICA IN ITS THIRD CENTURY.

TODAY, I'M RENEWING MY COMMITMENT TO THOSE GOALS.
WHETHER IT'S HELPING AMERICA'S FARMERS STAY ^{ON} ^{FARM} ~~IN THE BLACK~~
~~FIRST REDUCING AND THEN ELIMINATING~~ ^{ENSURING}
-- OR ~~BRINGING~~ THE DEFICIT UNDER CONTROL -- OR ~~KEEPING THE~~
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I BELIEVE THAT AMERICA'S GREATNESS STILL LIES AHEAD.
THE IDEAL NATION OUR FOUNDERS ENVISIONED MORE THAN 200
YEARS AGO IS YET TO BE ACHIEVED. WE'VE MADE GREAT
PROGRESS -- MORE THAN ANY OTHER NATION IN THE HISTORY OF
MANKIND. BUT WE CAN DO BETTER YET. WE CAN LEARN FROM
PLACES LIKE SOUTH DAKOTA, AND MY HOME STATE OF KANSAS.

SOUTH DAKOTA, LIKE KANSAS, IS PART OF WHAT PEOPLE
TODAY CALL MIDDLE AMERICA -- HERE ON THESE GREAT PLAINS,
RUNNING FROM CANADA TO THE GULF COAST. A LOT OF
HISTORIANS SAY THE MIDWEST IS THE MOST AMERICAN PART OF
AMERICA.

BY THAT, THEY CERTAINLY DON'T MEAN TO SAY THAT
MIDWESTERNERS ARE BETTER THAN ANYBODY ELSE IN THE
COUNTRY. BUT THE CIRCUMSTANCES OF HISTORY HAVE HELPED THE
MIDWEST TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE AGAIN AND AGAIN IN AMERICA'S
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WHAT MAKES THE MIDWEST PARTICULARLY AMERICAN IS THAT
IT WAS POPULATED LARGELY BY PEOPLE WHO MOVED NORTH AND
WEST FROM THE CONFEDERACY -- AND SOUTH AND WEST FROM NEW
ENGLAND.

THERE THEY MET PEOPLE FROM JUST ABOUT EVERY COUNTRY
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MIDWEST, MANY MOVED FURTHER WEST, TO THE MOUNTAINS AND TO
THE COASTS OF CALIFORNIA.

THAT'S WHY THE MIDWEST HAS BEEN CALLED THE CRUCIBLE
OF THE NATION. IT'S WHERE THE MELTING POT DID ITS MELTING
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AND THE GREATNESS OF THESE UNITED STATES IS THAT THE
MELTING AND MIXING CONTINUES. SURE, IT'S NOT EASY AT
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. . . AND AFGHANI MERCHANTS, YOU CAN SEE HOW THIS GREAT
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BACK IN KANSAS, AS A YOUNG BOY, I LEARNED -- WE ALL
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DEFEATING THE DEFICIT

THE NEXT PRESIDENT WILL FACE ONE MONSTER OF A HARD
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DEFICIT.

THE NEXT PRESIDENT IS GOING TO HAVE TO COMMIT THE
CITIZENS OF THIS NATION TO DEALING WITH THIS SINGLE
GREATEST THREAT TO A PROSPEROUS AND SECURE AMERICA. MOST
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TALKING A GOOD GAME, POINTING WITH ALARM TO THE DEFICIT.

BUT ONLY ONE OF US IS LAYING OUT ANY REAL SOLUTIONS
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SPENDING FROM MY FIRST WEEK IN OFFICE. ONLY ONE OF US IS
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I'M WILLING TO ADMIT THAT A FREEZE IS NOT THE BEST ANSWER. IT HAS SOME DRAWBACKS. BUT IT PUTS A LID ON SPENDING -- EXCEPT FOR THOSE PROGRAMS THAT BENEFIT THOSE UNABLE TO CARE FOR THEMSELVES.

AND IT BUYS US TIME -- TIME TO GO THROUGH THE BUDGET AND ELIMINATE THE INEFFECTIVE AND INEFFICIENT PROGRAMS THAT SAP THE FEDERAL TREASURY.

IT BUYS US TIME TO PUSH HARD FOR A LINE-ITEM VETO -- A TOOL THAT WILL GIVE THE PRESIDENT THE POWER TO FASHION A SENSIBLE BUDGET -- AND NOT ONE LARDED WITH PROGRAMS TO WARM EVERY LOBBYIST'S HEART.

SO I INTEND TO KILL THE DEFICIT -- AND KILL IT WITH COMMON SENSE. WE'LL DO IT IN A CAREFUL, BIPARTISAN WAY THAT WILL MAKE SURE IT STAYS DEAD.

AND WE'RE GOING TO DO IT WITHOUT PUTTING ANY ADDITIONAL BURDENS ON THE BACKS OF SOCIAL SECURITY RECIPIENTS. AS ONE WHO FORGED A CONSENSUS ON THE PLAN TO SAVE SOCIAL SECURITY FROM BANKRUPTCY IN 1983, I AM ONE CANDIDATE WHO HAS DEMONSTRATED HIS COMMITMENT TO KEEPING THOSE BROWN ENVELOPES COMING -- WITH A CHECK INSIDE.

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A SECURE FUTURE

GETTING RID OF THE DEFICIT IS JUST AS IMPORTANT FOR AMERICA'S INTERNATIONAL POSITION AS IT IS FOR OUR WELL-BEING HERE AT HOME. THE REST OF THE WORLD KNOWS -- THE SOVIETS KNOW, THE JAPANESE KNOW, OUR ADVERSARIES AND OUR ALLIES ALL KNOW -- THAT WE CANNOT HOLD OUR OWN IN TODAY'S WORLD UNLESS WE DEMONSTRATE THE POLITICAL WILL TO DEAL WITH THE DEFICIT.

THIS PAST DECADE -- THE 1980S -- HAS BEEN A DECADE OF GROWTH, PROSPERITY AND PEACE FOR AMERICA, THANKS TO THE LEADERSHIP OF ONE MAN, RONALD REAGAN.

BUT THE NEXT PRESIDENT MUST BE PREPARED TO DEAL WITH A VASTLY DIFFERENT WORLD THAN WE HAVE FACED OVER THE PAST QUARTER OF A CENTURY. NOT SINCE THE YEARS IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING WORLD WAR II HAVE WE FACED A CHALLENGE SO GREAT AND SO POTENT. HOW WE RESPOND TO THAT CHALLENGE WILL DETERMINE WHETHER OUR SECURITY, OUR PROSPERITY AND OUR STATURE IN THE WORLD WILL FLOURISH INTO THE NEXT CENTURY OR WHETHER WE WILL RETREAT AND DECLINE.

AS MUCH AS IN THOSE DARK AND DANGEROUS POST-WORLD WAR II YEARS, OUR RESPONSE WILL DEMAND STRONG, DECISIVE LEADERSHIP, IMAGINATION AND COURAGE.

IN BRINGING THAT KIND OF RESOLVE, WE'RE GOING TO HAVE TO START WITH SOME BASICS -- BASICS LIKE FREEDOM AND COMMUNISM. I HAVE GRAPPLED WITH ISSUES OF U.S.-SOVIET RELATIONS THROUGHOUT THREE DECADES OF PUBLIC LIFE. I HAVE VISITED THE SOVIET UNION. I HAVE MET MIKHAIL GORBACHEV. AND, BASED ON ALL THAT, I CAN TELL YOU TWO THINGS

WHATEVER GLASNOST IS, IT IS NOT DEMOCRACY.

WHATEVER GORBACHEV IS, HE IS STILL A HARD-AS-NAILS COMMUNIST.

WHEN MIKHAIL GORBACHEV LEFT WASHINGTON A FEW WEEKS BACK, WITH MANY STILL IN THE GRIP OF GLASNOST FEVER, HE FLEW BACK TO A GODLESS COMMUNIST STATE -- WITH VERY LITTLE FREEDOM -- TO A MISERABLE STANDARD OF LIVING. THAT'S WHERE MIKHAIL GORBACHEV WOKE UP THE NEXT DAY.

BUT WE -- ALL OF US -- AWOKE IN THE FREEST AND MOST JUST COUNTRY IN THE WORLD.

WE MUST NEVER FORGET THAT DIFFERENCE.

SO WHEN WE DEAL WITH THE SOVIETS, IT MUST ALWAYS BE FROM STRENGTH.

WHEN WE TALK TO MR. GORBACHEV, AS WE SHOULD -- IT SHOULD NEVER BE IN BLIND FAITH.

WE ELECTED RONALD REAGAN BECAUSE HE ARTICULATED WHAT WAS IN OUR HEARTS -- THAT AMERICA REALLY IS THE BEST COUNTRY IN THE WORLD -- AND REALLY IS THE BASTION OF DEMOCRACY AROUND THE WORLD.

THE NEXT PRESIDENT WILL FACE NEW AND DIFFERENT CHALLENGES. HE WILL HAVE TO SHOW SHOW HIS OWN STYLE OF LEADERSHIP -- AND FORGE HIS OWN STRATEGIES FOR DEALING WITH EMERGING ISSUES.

BUT HE CANNOT TURN HIS BACK ON THE BASIC PRINCIPLES THAT RONALD REAGAN ARTICULATED. OR FORGET THE LASTING LESSONS THAT RONALD REAGAN TAUGHT US -- ESPECIALLY IN THE SPHERE OF DEALING WITH THE SOVIETS. IN GETTING THE INF AGREEMENT, RONALD REAGAN TAUGHT US THE RIGHT WAY: WE SET GOOD GOALS. WE STICK TO THEM. AND WE EXTRACT CONCESSIONS FROM THE SOVIETS.

NOW IS NOT THE TIME TO TURN FROM THAT PATH, AND MOVE BACK TO THE APOLOGIST POLICIES OF APPEASEMENT AND UNILATERAL CONCESSION.

MY GENERATION HAS SEEN THIS COUNTRY AND THIS WORLD GO THROUGH A LOT OF CHANGES. FROM THE HARD DAYS OF THE DEPRESSION TO THE GREAT AND TRAGIC YEARS OF WORLD WAR II.

THEN CAME THE HEADY DAYS OF THE FIFTIES, THE TROUBLING
TIMES OF THE SIXTIES, AND THE MALAISE OF THE SEVENTIES.
RONALD REAGAN IN THE 1980S HAS MADE THIS COUNTRY STRONG
AGAIN, REDEDICATED TO OUR PURPOSE IN THE WORLD.

AND THAT'S HOW WE ARE GOING TO MOVE INTO THE 1990S
AND THE 21ST CENTURY, WITH COMMON SENSE AND COMPASSION.

THAT'S WHAT I'VE WORKED AT MY ENTIRE LIFE, AND THAT'S
WHAT I SEE FOR US IN THE FUTURE. IT COMES FROM MY
MIDWESTERN ROOTS. IT COMES FROM KNOWING HOW PEOPLE WORK
AND WHAT THEY WORK FOR.

SO IF I TALK TOO MUCH IN THE ARCANE LANGUAGE OF
BUDGETS AND LEGISLATIVE STRATEGIES, IT'S BECAUSE THAT'S
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SENSE AND COMPASSION. IT'S NOT ABOUT WALKING AWAY FROM
RESPONSIBILITIES. I NEVER HAVE, AND I NEVER WILL.

LEADERSHIP MAKES A DIFFERENCE

I INTEND TO WIN IN THIS CAMPAIGN. WINNING IS WHAT
AMERICA IS ALL ABOUT. AND TO WIN, YOU NEED A STRONG,
RESILIENT, EXPERIENCED LEADER -- WHETHER IT IS IN BUSINESS
OR GOVERNMENT. THE REPUBLICAN PARTY IS FORTUNATE THAT ANY
ONE OF ITS POTENTIAL PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATES HAS MORE
EXPERIENCE, MORE ABILITY, MORE STRENGTH THAN ANY ONE OF
THE DEMOCRATIC CANDIDATES.

I KNOW THAT VOTERS IN SOUTH DAKOTA TAKE THEIR ROLES SERIOUSLY.
