

**SUGGESTED TALKING POINTS
SENATOR BOB DOLE**

- ◆ I UNDERSTAND THIS GROUP IS WELL ON THE WAY TO RAISING \$1.5 MILLION OF THE PRESIDENT'S DINNER \$7 MILLION GOAL FOR OUR REPUBLICAN CANDIDATES.
- ◆ EACH YEAR, THIS GROUP OF WASHINGTON AREA VICE CHAIRMEN HAS BEEN RESPONSIBLE FOR HELPING TO MAKE THE PRESIDENT'S DINNER THE LARGEST AND MOST SUCCESSFUL ANNUAL FUNDRAISER IN THE HISTORY OF THE REPUBLICAN PARTY.
- ◆ ON BEHALF OF THE U.S. SENATE, I WANT TO THANK YOU FOR ALL YOU ARE DOING FOR OUR REPUBLICAN CANDIDATES.

- ◆ HOWARD BAKER HAS BEEN MAJORITY LEADER AND MINORITY LEADER IN THE SENATE AND THERE'S NO QUESTION WHICH JOB HE LIKED BETTER!
- ◆ WE NEED TO GUARANTEE THE MAXIMUM FINANCIAL COMMITMENT TO OUR SENATE AND HOUSE CANDIDATES IN 1990. MAXIMUM FUNDING WILL MEAN THE WINNING MARGIN IN EACH AND EVERY CAMPAIGN.
