SUBJECT: Independent Bakers Association Breakfast Speech

Time and Location:

The breakfast will be at the Washington Court Hotel between 8:00 and 9:30 a.m.. Any time at your convenience they would like you to drop by and speak for 10 minutes followed by a Q&A.

Chris Freihofer, former Chairman of the Independent Bakers Association, will introduce you. He owns Freihofer Baking, which makes Entenmann's bakery goods (the best Danish in the world).

What they want you to talk about:

You are the last speaker at their 3 day conference. By the time you speak they will have heard a lot on the farm bill, so they won't be interested in hearing much more about it. Instead, they would like a general overview of the 1990 elections, the budget summit, and the legislative agenda -- basically whatever you want to talk about is fine with them.
