THE WORLD SITUATION

- 0 THANK YOU.
- 0 IN AN ELECTION YEAR, IT ALWAYS GETS A LITTLE CRAZY IN THIS TOWN. AS USUAL, WE'RE SEEING A A

"BULL MARKET" IN **PARTISAN POSTURING, AND** A "BEAR MARKET" IN STATESMANSHIP AND COMMON SENSE. **GEORGE BUSH HAS BEEN TAKING MORE THAN HIS** FAIR SHARE OF "HITS" --**INCLUDING FROM A FEW IN** HIS OWN PARTY. ONE OF

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YEAR. THAT IS WELL MORE THAN TWICE THE SIZE OF THE ENTIRE FEDERAL **BUDGET WHEN I WAS FIRST ELECTED TO CONGRESS. MY GENERATION WILL PROBABLY ESCAPE THE** WORST CONSEQUENCES OF **DEFICIT SPENDING, BUT** WHAT DO WE TELL OUR

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GOVERNMENT HAVE TO PICK UP THE TAB FOR SOMEBODY MAKING GOOD MONEY FOR PART B **MEDICARE? BEHIND CLOSED DOORS, MOST** PEOPLE CAN AGREE THERE **IS A PROBLEM HERE, BUT** NOBODY, NOT **REPUBLICANS, NOT**

DEMOCRATS, WANTS TO BE THE FIRST TO PUT IT ON THE TABLE. SO, WE END UP DOING NOTHING TO CONTROL THE COST OF ENTITLEMENT. **MY FEELING IS THAT WE** WILL NOT MAKE ANY **PROGRESS RESTRAINING** THE BUDGET UNTIL WE GET

TO THE POINT WHERE CONGRESS IS WILLING TO FREEZE ENTITLEMENT PROGRAMS. PEACE DIVIDEND THERE IS SOME

WILLINGNESS IN CONGRESS **TO LOOK AT SPENDING, BUT** THE SPENDING DEMOCRATS **ARE LOOKING AT IS DEFENSE SPENDING. RIGHT**

NOW, THE SENATE IS **DEBATING A BILL TO REMOVE THE SO-CALLED** FIREWALL BETWEEN **DEFENSE SPENDING AND** DOMESTIC SPENDING THAT WAS AGREED TO IN THE **BUDGET SUMMIT.** THIS WILL GIVE THE 0 **DEMOCRATS THE LICENSE**

OFFICE EXPLAINING WHAT \$100 TO \$150 BILLION CUTS OF THIS SIZE WILL DO TO THE ECONOMY. NOW, DON'T MISUNDERSTAND ME, DEFENSE WAS NEVER MEANT TO BE A JOBS **PROGRAM, BUT WHAT ARE** YOU GOING TO DO WITH--THEY ARE REAL

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PEOPLE WORKING IN DEFENSE PLANTS. I KNOW A LOT OF YOUNG MEN AND WOMEN WHO SIGNED UP FOR THE **ALL-VOLUNTEER ARMY WHO ARE BEING TOLD NOW TO** GO ON HOME, WE DON'T NEED YOU ANY MORE. AND THEY'RE BACK ON THE

STREETS IN RUSSELL, **KANSAS AND AROUND THE** COUNTRY LOOKING FOR WORK, WITH EVERYBODY ELSE LOOKING FOR WORK. I THINK THAT'S RATHER SHABBY TREATMENT **MYSELF, OF YOUNG MEN** AND YOUNG WOMEN. WE SAID SIGN UP FOR 10 OR 15
