5:45 p.m.	Mags Open. 5 piece Dixieland Band begins playing at entrance.
6:00 p.m.	Bars Open
6:00 p.m.	Guests begin arriving for the Reception in Lobbies 1 and 2.
6:30 p.m.	Head Table Guests escorted to the VIP Holding Room in Lobby 5.
7:10 p.m.	Bars close.
7:13 p.m.	Guests begin entering Hall A.
7:15 p.m.	Vice President and Mrs. Quayle arrive via Hall D and proceed to the VIP Holding Room in Lobby 5.
7:25 p.m.	President and Mrs. Bush arrive via Hall D and proceed to the VIP Holding Room in Lobby 5.
7:35 - 7:40 p.m.	President and Mrs. Bush, Vice President and Mrs. Quayle, and Dinner Chairman, Senator Howard Baker, Jr. and Mrs. Baker depart Holding Room and proceed to an adjoining, private Holding Room where the President will present a gift to Senator Baker.
7:45 p.m.	Head Table guests proceed to seating from VIP Holding Room.
7:47 p.m.	Vice President and Mrs. Quayle proceed to off-stage holding location to be introduced.

(Minute-By-Minute - 2)

7:49 p.m.	Vice President and Mrs. Quayle are announced and proceed to Head Table.
7:50 p.m.	President and Mrs. Bush proceed to off-stage holding location to be introduced.
7:52 - 7:55 p.m.	President and Mrs. Bush are announced and proceed to Head Table. The Capitol Band plays Ruffles and Flourishes and Hail to the Chief.
7:56 - 8:01 p.m.	Senator Baker asks guests to take their seats, and welcomes all to The Dinner . At the conclusion of brief remarks Senator Baker introduces Dr. Richard Halverson.
8:01 - 8:03 p.m.	Invocation by Dr. Richard Halverson.
8:03 - 8:05 p.m.	Immediately following the invocation, Terrill Pierce will proceed to Center Stage and sing the National Anthem.
8:06 - 8:07 p.m.	National Anthem.
8:07 p.m.	Senator Baker asks guests to remain standing and introduces XXXXXXXXXXXX who will lead guests in the Pledge of Allegiance.
8:07 p.m.	XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX proceeds to the Center Stage.
8:07 - 8:08 p.m.	XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX leads the Pledge of Allegiance, Center Stage.
8:09 p.m.	Person leading the pledge is escorted back to their table.
8:09 - 8:11 p.m.	Senator Baker thanks pledge and invocation people and proceeds to introduce members of the Cabinet.

8:11 p.m.	Entree is served. Music plays continuous throughout Dinner.
8:55 p.m.	Off stage announcement requesting all guests to return to their seats.
8:55 - 9:00 p.m.	Senator Baker gives a historical perspective of The Dinner and introduces The Dinner Leadership and Senator Bob Dole to recognize the Republican Members of the Senate.
9:00 - 9:02 p.m.	Senator Bob Dole makes remarks for 2 minutes, recognizes Republican members of the Senate and introduces Congressman Bob Michel.
9:02 - 9:04 p.m.	Congressman Bob Michel makes remarks and recognizes the Republican Members of the House for 2 minutes and introduces Senator Phil Gramm, Chairman of the NRSC.
9:04 - 9:09 p.m.	Senator Phil Gramm makes remarks and introduces Vice President Dan Quayle.
9:09 - 9:14 p.m.	Vice President Dan Quayle makes remarks.
9:14 - 9:16 p.m.	Senator Baker thanks the Vice President and introduces Congressman Guy Vander Jagt, Chairman of the NRCC.
9:16 - 9:21 p.m.	Congressman Guy Vander Jagt makes remarks and introduces President Bush.
9:21 - 9:31 p.m.	President George Bush makes remarks.
9:31 - 9:33 p.m.	Senator Baker thanks President Bush and introduces top fundraiser.

(Minute-By-Minute - 4)

9:33 - 9:35 p.m.	Top fundraiser makes toast to the President.
9:35 - 9:37 p.m.	Senator Baker thanks the top fundraiser. He then introduces the final entertainment.
9:37 - 9:47 p.m.	Entertainment
9:47 - 9:50 p.m.	Senator Baker invites guests to join him downstairs for dessert and dancing at the Apres Reception and asks them to remain seated until the President and Vice President depart.
9:50 - 9:52 p.m.	Music plays as President and Mrs. Bush and Vice President and Mrs. Quayle depart.
9:53 p.m.	Guests depart Hall A.
10:00 - 12:00 a.m.	Apres Reception.
