TO WORK TOGETHER, QUICKLY,
IN A BIPARTISAN WAY, TO
APPROVE SHORT-TERM HELP,

SUCH AS THE PRESIDENT'S

URBAN ENTERPRISE ZONES,

LIKE ALMOST ANYTHING, THIS KIND OF PROGRAM WOULDN'T BE CHEAP. NOTWITHSTANDING THE SAVINGS WE MIGHT GAIN FROM GETTING PEOPLE OFF WELFARE, WE NEED TO FIND A WAY TO PAY FOR IT. NOW, THOSE ORIGINAL DEPRESSION PROGRAMS WOULD COST ABOUT \$90 BILLION IN TODAY'S

DOLLARS -- BUT BEFORE YOU
GET STICKER SHOCK, CONSIDER
ANOTHER PRICE TAG: DURING
THE PAST EIGHT YEARS,
WELFARE HAS COST YOU, THE
TAXPAYER, TEN TIMES THAT
AMOUNT, ABOUT \$932 BILLION.

ALL OF THESE SO-CALLED
SOLUTIONS WOULD BE A LOT
EASIER TO DO IF WE DIDN'T

HAVE TO WORRY ABOUT PUBLIC **ENEMY NUMBER ONE -- THE BUDGET DEFICIT. AND THAT'S** REALLY MY MAIN POINT TODAY. IMAGINE ALL THE GREAT THINGS WE COULD DO, ALL THE **WORTHWHILE PROGRAMS WE** COULD TRY -- FOR URBAN AND **RURAL AMERICA -- IF WE HAD** THE MONEY TO PAY FOR THEM. BY THE END OF THIS YEAR,

THE NATIONAL DEBT WILL **EXCEED \$4 TRILLION DOLLARS --**THAT'S RIGHT, \$4 TRILLION WITH A "T". FOR THAT MUCH MONEY, WE COULD BUY AN AVERAGE SIZE IN-GROUND CONCRETE SWIMMING POOL FOR EVERY HOMEOWNER IN AMERICA, PAY A 40-HOUR WEEK MINIMUM WAGE PAYCHECK TO EVERY PERSON IN THE WORLD, PAY A

YEAR OF TUITION TO HARVARD FOR EVERY PERSON UNDER 18 IN THE U.S., AND SEND EVERY PERSON IN THE COUNTRY OVER THE AGE OF 18 ON A TWO-WEEK "CLUB MED VACATION -- WE COULD DO ALL OF THOSE THINGS AND HAVE \$3 TRILLION **LEFT OVER! BUT WE AREN'T GETTING** THESE, OR ANY OTHER BENEFITS

FROM THE DEFICIT -- WE'RE PAYING FOR IT, BIGTIME. IT BOILS DOWN TO BASIC **ECONOMICS. BORROWING TO** FINANCE FEDERAL DEFICITS DRAINS THE PRIVATE SECTOR OF SAVINGS. TO MEET OUR INVESTMENT NEEDS, INTEREST RATES GO UP TO ATTRACT FINANCIAL CAPITAL. HIGHER INTEREST RATES HURT

CONSUMERS, BORROWERS AND PRODUCERS IN MANY WAYS, RIGHT IN THE POCKETBOOK. WE HEAR A LOT OF TALK ABOUT HOW BAD THE DEFICIT IS, BUT LET ME GIVE YOU A FEW **EXAMPLES OF WHAT A ONE** PERCENTAGE POINT INCREASE IN INTEREST RATES REALLY MEANS TO REAL PEOPLE IN THE **REAL WORLD:**

♦ ACCORDING TO THE SENATE BUDGET COMMITTEE, A ONE PERCENT INCREASE IN INTEREST RATES RAISES THE COST OF PAYING OFF THE NATIONAL DEBT BY ABOUT \$30 BILLION PER YEAR, OR **ANOTHER \$273 OWED BY EACH AND EVERY TAXPAYER -**- THAT MEANS YOU.

♦ IT ALSO ADDS \$1000 PER
YEAR TO THE COST OF HOME
OWNERSHIP, REDUCING NEW
HOME SALES BY AN
ESTIMATED 75,000 HOMES
PER YEAR -- THAT'S ♣ A
LOT OF JOBS.

♦ AN AVERAGE 36-MONTH CAR LOAN WOULD COST AN EXTRA \$160, LOWERING AUTO SALES

BY 350,000 CARS AND
TRUCKS, A LOSS OF NEARLY
\$6 BILLION IN AUTO INDUSTRY
REVENUE -- THAT, TOO, IS A
LOT OF JOBS -- JOBS WE
CAN'T AFFORD TO LOSE.

♦ AND ADDING ONE PERCENT
TO INTEREST RATES COULD
REDUCE BUSINESS
INVESTMENT BY AS MUCH AS

4% DURING A THREE YEAR
PERIOD -- AGAIN, MORE JOBS
ON THE ENDANGERED LIST.

BUT THE PROBLEMS CAUSED
BY THE DEFICIT'S DAMAGE TO
JOBS, SAVINGS AND
INVESTMENT DOESN'T STOP AT
HIGHER INTEREST RATES. TO
MEET OUR NEEDS, FINANCIAL
CAPITAL WOULD HAVE TO COME

FROM ABROAD, BOOSTING THE EXCHANGE RATE VALUE OF THE DOLLAR.

◆ ACCORDING TO THE BUDGET COMMITTEE, IF THE VALUE OF THE DOLLAR ROSE BY 5%, FOR EXAMPLE, FOREIGN DEMAND FOR WHEAT COULD FALL BY AS MUCH AS 10%. EXCESS WHEAT SUPPLIES

COULD DRIVE DOWN DOMESTIC PRICES, PERHAPS BY AS MUCH AS 25 CENTS PER BUSHEL. A 10% **DECREASE IN WHEAT CASH** RECEIPTS COULD TRANSLATE INTO AN \$800 MILLION LOSS FOR WHEAT FARMERS AND TAXPAYERS WHO PROVIDE FARM INCOME SUPPORT.



♦ NO DOUBT ABOUT IT, OTHER EXPORT INDUSTRIES COULD SUFFER, TOO, INCLUDING AIRCRAFT MANUFACTURING AND MANUFACTURED CONSUMER DURABLE GOODS.

SO HOW DO WE FIGHT THE

DEFICIT MENACE? WE

CERTAINLY CAN'T WIPE IT OUT

WITH THE SO-CALLED PEACE DIVIDEND. REMEMBER THE 90 PEACE DIVIDEND? THAT'S THAT CLEVER PHRASE BIG-SPENDING LIBERALS PREFERRED TO USE FOR THEIR ALL-OUT RAID ON THE DEFENSE BUDGET SO THEY COULD DUMP EVEN MORE MONEY ON BIG GOVERNMENT PROGRAMS, ALL IN THE NAME OF "PEACE," OF COURSE. YES,

THE PENTAGON BUDGET SHOULD BE SCALED BACK IN THE LIGHT OF A NEW WORLD ORDER, BUT GUTTING IT MAKES NO SENSE AND IS JUST PLAIN DANGEROUS TO OUR SECURITY. WHEN SADDAM HUSSEIN SPARKED THE GULF WAR, MOST **AMERICANS WERE PRETTY** IMPRESSED WITH THE "BIG RED ONE," THE KC-135 AIR

REFUELING TANKERS, PILOTS FROM McCONNELL AIR FORCE BASE AND A LOT OF OTHER MADE-IN-KANSAS KNOWHOW AND MANPOWER THAT HELPED DELIVER OUR STUNNING VICTORY. SO LET'S NOT HANG A "CLOSED" SIGN ON FORT RILEY, OR McCONNELL, OR BOEING JUST BECAUSE SOMEONE TELLS US IT'S TIME TO DISMANTLE

DEFENSE, BECAUSE NOBODY CAN PREDICT WHERE THE NEX THREAT WILL COME FROM. **ACTUALLY, A LOT OF THE** LIBERAL DEMOCRATS WHO **USED TO FIGHT DEFENSE** SPENDING EVERY STEP OF THE WAY HAVE AWAKENED, BUT THEY WOKE UP ON THE WRONG SIDE OF THE BED. IT'S IRONIC THAT A LOT OF THEM ARE NOW

YOU KNOW THAT HASN'T DONE THE TRICK.

ONE IDEA THAT IS REALLY **GAINING STEAM IS THE** CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO BALANCE THE BUDGET. I'VE ALWAYS BEEN FOR A BALANCED **BUDGET AMENDMENT, BUT IN** THE CURRENT REFORM ATMOSPHERE, THE AMENDMENT HAS BECOME A SORT OF "LIFE

RAFT" -- EVERYBODY'S JUMPING ON BOARD TO RIDE TO SAFETY FROM THEIR BOUNCED CHECKS, **BAD VOTING RECORDS AND** SLUMPING POPULARITY POLLS. IF THINGS GET ANY WORSE FOR SOME INCUMBENTS, THEY MAY **EVEN START ENDORSING THE** LINE-ITEM VETO PRESIDENTS HAVE WANTED FOR YEARS. SO, FOR WHATEVER REASON,

IT APPEARS THAT A NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF CONGRESS HAVE "FOUND RELIGION" WHEN IT COMES TO THE BALANCED BUDGET AMENDMENT. WE WELCOME THEIR NEW-FOUND ENTHUSIASM, BUT WE WILL INSIST THAT ANY BALANCED **BUDGET AMENDMENT BE A GOOD BALANCED-BUDGET AMENDMENT -- IN OTHER**

SMOKESCREEN FOR RAISING
TAXES, BUT RATHER A TOUGH
DOSE OF DISCIPLINE THAT WILL
ENCOURAGE SPENDING
RESTRAINT AND COMMONSENSE
BUDGET POLICIES.

DRAFTING THE RIGHT

AMENDMENT MAY BE THE REAL

CHALLENGE -- THERE ARE A

FEW DIFFERENT APPROACHES

FLOATING AROUND, BUT ONE PROMISING WAY TO DISCIPLINE THE BIG SPENDERS IS WITH A **BALANCED BUDGET** AMENDMENT THAT ALSO MAKES IT HARDER FOR WASHINGTON TO GET ITS HANDS ON YOUR TAX DOLLARS. THIS AMENDMENT WOULD **ENCOURAGE SPENDING CUTS** AS OPPOSED TO TAX HIKES -- TO

BALANCE THE NATION'S BOOKS BY REQUIRING A THREE-FIFTHS **VOTE OF CONGRESS -- INSTEAD** OF A SIMPLE MAJORITY VOTE --TO RAISE TAXES. AFTER ALL, WE DON'T WANT TO BALANCE THE BUDGET BY BOOSTING **TAXES A WHOPPING \$300 BILLION TO \$400 BILLION A YEAR** TO FINANCE EXTRAVAGANT SPENDING PROGRAMS.

ENFORCEMENT IS ANOTHER TRICKY, BUT IMPORTANT, QUESTION. THE BALANCED BUDGET POLICE FORCE COULD END UP BEING THE COURTS, STANDING READY TO ORDER TAXATION OR SPENDING CUTS TO GET THE JOB DONE IF CONGRESS AND THE PRESIDENT COMMIT BUDGET MALPRACTICE. I BELIEVE AN AMENDMENT

WILL PROBABLY PASS **CONGRESS THIS YEAR, AND** WE'LL SEND IT TO THE STATES FOR RATIFICATION. WHAT WILL HAPPEN THERE, I'M NOT CERTAIN, BUT I DON'T THINK IT'LL TAKE US 203 YEARS TO **GET AN ANSWER LIKE IT DID** WITH THE NEW 27TH AMENDMENT. THE BOTTOM LINE IS,

PROMISES WON'T DO IT. IF THE 11 **BIG SPENDERS ARE SO SERIOUS** ABOUT DISCIPLINING THEMSELVES, WE'D BETTER GET IT IN WRITING -- IN THE U.S. CONSTITUTION. EVERYTHING **OUGHT TO BE PAID FOR -- NO** MORE EXCUSES TO KEEP THE BIG GOVERNMENT SPENDING MACHINE WORKING OVERTIME. AND MORE IMPORTANTLY, NO
