BILLION--I DON'T THINK IT WILL
HELP MUCH IN A TRILLION

DOLLAR ECONOMY...BUT IT WILL
ADD TO OUR \$300 BILLION

DEFICIT.

*DESPITE THE GOOD NEWS
FROM THE BUSH RECOVERY,
SOME ECONOMISTS HAVE
POINTED OUT THAT JOB
CREATION HAS LAGGED BEHIND

OTHER ECONOMIC INDICATORS. *AND ONE THING I KNOW IS THAT IT WILL LAG EVEN FURTHER BEHIND IN PRESIDENT CLINTON CONTINUES TO CALL FOR MORE TAXES, MORE RED INK, AND MORE GOVERNMENT MANDATES.

*THE FIRST BILL PASSED BY
